We naturally want you to enjoy your stay with us and would like to make the following suggestions of how you can assist us in our commitment to responsible tourism.

- Conserve energy – reduce energy by switching off lights and closing windows if heating is on. Information on what you can do at home is available from the Energy Saving Trust
- Reduce, Reuse, Recycle – Try to avoid overly packaged goods and say no to that extra carrier bag. Use a ‘bag for life’ which are available now from most large stores or ask if paper carriers are available instead. Recycle whenever possible – we have recycling facilities for glass, plastic, paper and cardboard which guests are encouraged to use.
- Be water wise – Please use water sparingly. Turn the tap off when brushing your teeth, use the shower rather than filling a bath, dispose of facial tissues in the bin rather than flushing them away unnecessarily and follow towel usage guidance.
- Give the car a rest – If only for one day, leave the car behind and walk, cycle or use public transport. Details of local walks and cycle hire are available from reception.
- Respect Nature – Help us to look after the landscape and wildlife by not littering, guarding against fire and using footpaths and cycle-ways responsibly. Please advise us if you see anything within our grounds which could have a detrimental effect on the environment.
- Shop Local – Use local products, they give you a real feel of the area and help to support our local community. Within the area we have some fantastic producers of food, drink, arts & crafts. Reception will be happy to advise you of local markets or organic food & drink producers.
- Support Green Tourism Businesses – Hundreds of businesses are trying to reduce their impact on the environment through the Green Tourism Business Scheme. Businesses are awarded Gold, Silver or Bronze award to reflect their efforts in being more environmentally friendly – see www.green-business.co.uk for more information.
